

OID SCHOLARSHIP FUND



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



Proof of Enrollment:

All applicants must present proof of enrollment in college or an accredited trade/vocational program. However, proof of enrollment requirement is waived for any applicant from the Clifton Boys Home in Jamaica.

Essay Requirement:

The applicant must submit an essay of 250 – 300 words on an essay topic chosen by the OID Scholarship Committee.

Application Form and Recommendations:

The applicant must complete the application form and submit it with two (2) letters of recommendation. One recommendation must be from a teacher at their current or most recent high school and one from a community organization such as a church, volunteer program, or other community program in which they participate.

Picture ID:

Each Application must include a current and valid picture ID of the applicant.

Submission Deadline:

Each Application must be submitted by the deadline to be determined. It is imperative to note that only fully completed applications, accompanied by all required supporting documentation, will be considered for the scholarships. These criteria ensure that applicants meet specific academic standards, contribute thoughtfully through the essay, and receive recommendations from both educational and community perspectives. OID is dedicated to fostering the educational journeys of deserving individuals, and adherence to these guidelines is crucial for a fair and comprehensive selection process.


Beyond his role as a phenomenal physician, Dr. Henry further impacted his community by mentoring aspiring students on their journey to becoming doctors.
